In our July workshop, **Buz Cabral** will discuss the construction and use of a photographic lightbox.

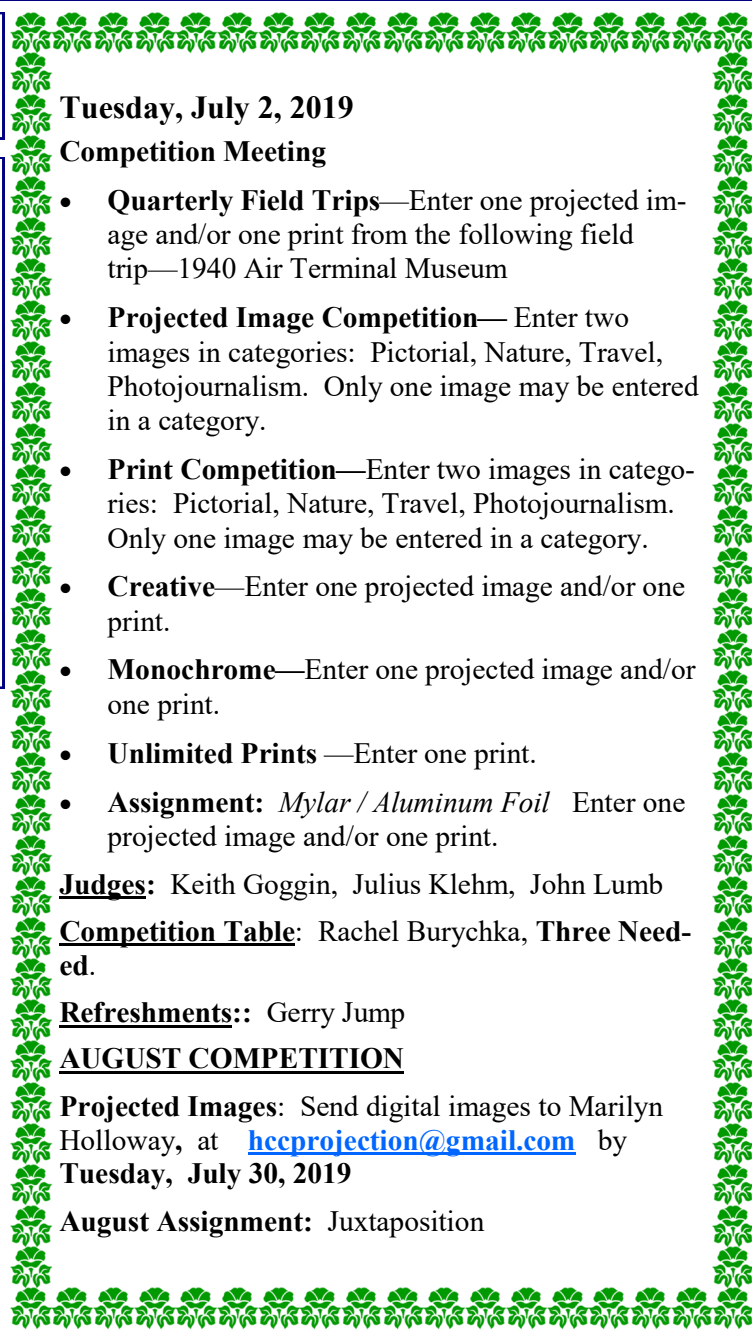
Bring your camera, a tripod, and flash as well as an object or two that you would like to photograph.

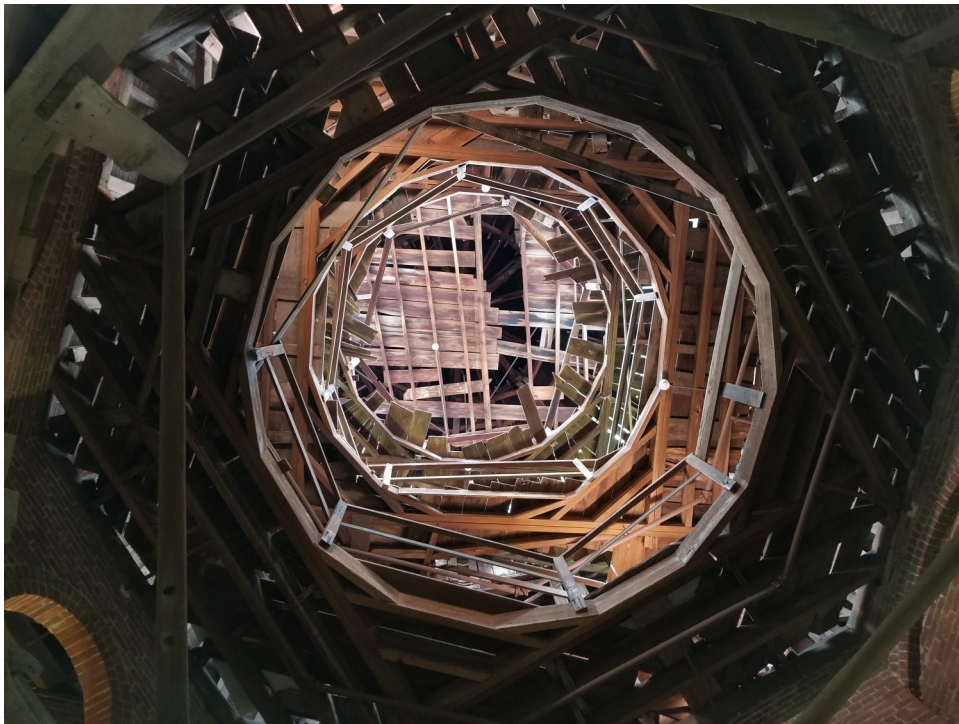
