Suggested Club Changes

The club Executive Committee met on September 4. The committee discussed several items to streamline club administration. We will discuss those briefly at the October competition meeting.

- It has been proposed to move Earl Gilbert Architectural Award submissions to March. In the last several years, low submissions required extensions from January to February, and then to March, to get enough entrants.
- It has been proposed that the competition year, annual high point competition, and fiscal year be brought into alignment. This change is proposed in order to reduce administrative workload. This will necessitate a change to the club constitution and by-laws.

This will require a vote of the membership on November 5.
