Foto Fest

Foto Fest Biennial 2022 is going on now in Houston. It will continue through November 6. There are a variety of exhibitions in galleries throughout Houston and a number of presentations are scheduled. Check the internet for more details. Most Foto Fest events are free to the public.

In conjunction with Foto Fest, there are several programs being presented by Czechoslovakian photographers. Konverzace is one which is presented by Czech photographers on October 3, 5:00 to 7:00pm, at the Czech Center Museum, 4920 Jan Jacinto St., Houston. There is information on the internet—search Konverzace Foto Fest.

Gwen Kunz has sent information on a Heritage Society exhibition of photographs entitled **Witness to a West Texas Boomtown**. Images were taken by photographer Basil Clemons from the 1920s to the 1940s. The photographs offer a view of the social history of small-town Texas and the cycle of boom and bust that characterizes the oil industry to this day. You can see this interesting exhibit at Albert & Ethel Herzstein Museum Gallery, 1100 Bagby Street, Houston. There is a \$5.00 fee for admission.

Another exhibit also sponsored by The Heritage Society is Joe Aker's **Faces of the other: Encounters in the midst of the city**. The images in this exhibit are portraits of people you might encounter in our world. Each measures 3 feet x 5 feet. All are mounted on fences surrounding San Houston Park in downtown Houston. The portrait of **Alice Atkinson**, a member of HCC, is in the exhibit. The address is 1100 Bagby Street, Houston.
