Workshop—April 15 On Line

Dion McGinnis The Seeing, not the Taking

The difference between taking an image that records what is in front of you and creating a photograph that conveys that which inspired you is your ability to see differently. Learning to see photography-worthy subject matter in the moment can often depend on your other senses and on your ability to translate inspiration to camera functions and processes.

The *Seeing, Not the Taking* guides attendees on how to see differently to change perspectives in order to find inspiration by tapping into:

- Your other senses
- Things you have read
- Things you believe
- Knowledge of camera functions and how the results impact creative decisions based on the previous three elements.

No matter your skill level, the ability to see inspiration in most every moment is a skill to be refined throughout your lifetime.

To prepare for this workshop:

- Jot down a few notes about your favorite subject matter and why it is so.
- Find three images created by other photographers of subjects that you like and make a few notes about what you admire and appreciate about their images.

You will be provided a few exercises to undertake after the workshop to put into practice some of the lessons learned.


